### CONTRACT SPECIFICATIONS

**6. Description of the contract**

The objective of the contract is the restoration of the original water flow capacity of the Baja-Bezdan canal at the Hungarian section by the dredging of the following km sections:

- 26+500 – 27+300
- 27+300 – 28+250
- 28+250 – 30+250
- 34+400 – 36+250

Additional objective is to establish driftwood removal platforms and boat ramps at the Hungarian section of the canal.

Driftwood removal platforms

- Hercegszántó 14+507 cskm
- Nagybaracska 28+283 cskm
- Bátmonostor 36+737 cskm

Boat ramps:

- Hercegszántó 14+020 cskm and 16+200 cskm
- Nagybaracska 27+283 cskm and 28+365 cskm
- Bátmonostor 36+678 cskm and 36+750 cskm

The works include the preparation of the construction design and plans by authorised designers

and the preparation of an explosive object disposal study as well as the implementation of the explosive discharging activity as necessitates by the study.

**TERMS OF PARTICIPATION**

**8. Eligibility and rules of origin**

Participation is open to all natural persons who are nationals of and legal persons (participating either individually or in a grouping – consortium - of tenderers) which are effectively established in a Member State of the European Union or in a eligible country or territory as defined under the Regulation (EU) N°236/2014 establishing common rules and procedures for the implementation of the Union's instruments for external action (CIR) for the applicable Instrument under which the contract is financed (see also heading 22 below) . Participation is also open to international organisations. All supplies under this contract must originate in one or more of these countries. However, they may originate from any country when the amount of the supplies to be purchased is below 100,000 euros per purchased.

**9. Grounds for exclusion**

Tenderers must submit a signed declaration, included in the Tender Form for a Works Contract, to the effect that they are not in any of the situations listed in point 2.3.3 of the **Practical Guide**.

**10. Number of tenders**

No more than one tender can be submitted by a natural or legal person whatever the form of participation (as an individual legal entity or as leader or member of a consortium submitting a tender). In the event that a natural or legal person submits more than one tender, all tenders in which that person has participated will be excluded. Tenderers may not submit a tender for a variant solution in addition to their tender for the works required in the tender dossier.

**11. Tender guarantee**

No tender guarantee is required.

**12. Performance guarantee**

The successful tenderer will be asked to provide a performance guarantee of 5% of the amount of the contract at the signing of the contract. This guarantee must be provided together with the return of the countersigned contract no later than 30 days after the tenderer receives the contract signed by the Contracting Authority. If the selected tenderer fails to provide such a guarantee within this period, the contract will be void and a new contract may be drawn up and sent to the tenderer which has submitted the next cheapest compliant tender.

**13. Information meeting and/or site visit**

A mandatory information meeting and site visit will be held on 15/08/2018, with the starting time of 11:00 (CET) at Baja Site Engineering office, 6500 Baja, Szeremlei u. 80.

The name(s) of the participant(s) has/have to be indicated by e-mail to the e-mail address given in point 18 at the latest on the day before.

**14. Tender validity**

Tenders must remain valid for a period of 90 days after the deadline for submission of tenders. In exceptional circumstances, the Contracting Authority may, before the validity period expires, request that tenderers extend the validity of tenders for a specific period.

**15. Period of implementation of tasks**

The final deadline of the implementation from the date indicated in the commencement order until the provisional acceptance is 31.03.2020.

**SELECTION AND AWARD CRITERIA**

**16. Selection criteria**

*1. Economic and financial capacity of candidate:*

- (a) the average annual turnover of the candidate in the past three years (2015, 2016 and 2017) must exceed the amount of EUR 2.000.000;

*2. Technical and professional capacity of candidate:*

- (a) it has the following employees:
  - 1. at least one employee who shall act as project leader during the completion of the contract and has at least 12 months professional experience in the leadership of non-water-utility related water engineering works (construction or reconstruction) closed with successful taking-over procedure, and has the qualifications and experience necessary to obtain the licence marked "MV-VZ" according to the Government decree 266/2013 (VII.11.) or already having that (or equivalent) licence. The completion of the contract shall only be commenced when the project leader has obtained that licence and is listed in the register of the Hungarian Chamber of Engineers as so;
  - 2. at least one employee who shall act as site manager during the completion of the contract and has at least 12 months professional experience in the site management of non-water-utility related water engineering works (construction or reconstruction) and has the qualifications and experience necessary to obtain the licence marked "MV-VZ" according to the Government decree 266/2013 (VII.11.) or already having that (or equivalent) licence. The completion of the contract shall only be commenced when the site manager has obtained that licence and is listed in the register of the Hungarian Chamber of Engineers as so;
- (b) it has completed and ended - in accordance with the prescriptions of the relevant contracts - two contracts which together include the following amount of water engineering works:
  - hidromechanisation dredging: min 50 000 m<sup>3</sup>
  - dredging from the shore: min. 20 000 m<sup>3</sup>
  - sheet-wall construction: min. 100 m<sup>2</sup>within the period of eight years before the deadline for submission of tenders (21/09/2018)

This means that the taking-over certificate of the contract the tenderer refers to must

have been issued within the indicated period, but it does not necessarily have to be started and completed during that period, nor implemented during the entire period.

The Contracting Authority reserves the right to ask for copies of certificates of the taking over certificate / final acceptance signed by the supervisors/contracting authority of the project concerned.;

- (c) it has at least the following construction machines:
  - 1 pc of tracked bog-crossing machine of min 18m boom radius and with sludge removing spoon.
  - 1 pc of hydromechanisation dredging machine with the dredging capacity of at least 25 m<sup>3</sup>/h dry material
  - 1 pc of tracked earthmoving dozer machine of at least 69 kW performance
  - 1 pc of tracked earthmoving dozer machine of at least 110 kW performance
- (d) if it is a sole tenderer it must carry out at least 70% of the contract works using its own resources, which means that it must have the equipment, materials, human and financial resources necessary to carry out that percentage of the contract.
- (e) if it is the lead member of a joint venture/consortium, it must be able to carry out at least 50% of the contract works using its own means.

If a tender is submitted by a consortium, unless specified, the selection criteria listed above will be applied to the consortium as a whole.

#### 17. Award criteria

The most economically advantageous tender is the technically compliant tender with the best price-quality ratio, determined by the results of the technical and financial evaluation in accordance with the weightings laid down below and in detail in the tender dossier:

Award criterion	Weighting
1. Price ( <b>net HUF</b> )	70
2. Professional experience of the project leader above the minimum required as selection criterion  Experience gained as project leader in construction or reconstruction of inland drainage canals and/or inland water systems projects (months) - max. 36 months	15
3. Professional experience of the site manager above the minimum required as selection criterion  Experience gained as site manager in construction or reconstruction of inland drainage canals and/or inland water systems projects (months) - max. 36 months	15

The key experts presented for the above mentioned award criteria have to be the same as that/those presented for the professional capacity (selection criteria).

The lower limit of score for each award criterion is 0 points; upper limit: 100 points, where 0 points are the worst, 100 points are the best value. Rounding will be calculated up to two decimal places.

The methods for calculating the scores for the award criteria are presented in the tender dossier.

**24. Additional information**

In this case, the Contracting Authority is obliged to disclose the reasons and justifications for the decision on terminating the contract in a written legal declaration with the Contractor.
