CONTRACT SPECIFICATIONS

6. Description of the contract

The objective is to improve the water management in the most affected region by water shortage of Hungary, in the south-region of the country called „Duna-Tisza közti Homokhátság”. The main volumes of the works to be implemented are the followings:

- laying down a 531 meters long DN 900 HOBAS pressure pipe between the 18+800 – 19+331 km cross sections of the water supply path;
- building a stilling basin and shutter weir at the 19+331 km cross-section of the water supply route
- new pumps with 18 m geodetic head and 752 l/sec discharge capacity will be built into the existing Domaszék pumping station with necessary electrical improvement
- canal bed development with dredging of the Domaszéki main canal between the 19+331 - 20+580 km sections
- building a new culvert at the 20+445 km cross-section of the water supply route in Domaszéki main canal,
- building a new intermediate pumping station (named Ivánszéki pump station), at the 20+580 km cross-section of the water supply route, with capacity of $Q=1,3-1,65\text{m}^3/\text{s}$ water quantity to a 3,5 m height;
- dredging the Domaszéki main canal, between the 20+580 – 23+996 km cross-sections of the water supply route and at this section 3 existing culvert reconstruction, also 8 gatted

- culvert are planned;
- establishment of a new electrical pump platform at the 23+996 km section of the water supply route (for ensure operation with electrical mobil pumps)
- preparing the implementation plan for the project elements – at least 4 pieces in paper format and one piece in digital format

TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

8. Eligibility and rules of origin

Participation is open to all natural persons who are nationals of and legal persons (participating either individually or in a grouping – consortium - of tenderers) which are effectively established in a Member State of the European Union or in a eligible country or territory as defined under the Regulation (EU) N°236/2014 establishing common rules and procedures for the implementation of the Union's instruments for external action (CIR) for the applicable Instrument under which the contract is financed (see also heading 22 below) . Participation is also open to international organisations. All supplies under this contract must originate in one or more of these countries. However, they may originate from any country when the amount of the supplies to be purchased is below 100,000 euros per purchased.

9. Grounds for exclusion

Tenderers must submit a signed declaration, included in the Tender Form for a Works Contract, to the effect that they are not in any of the situations listed in point 2.3.3 of the **Practical Guide**.

10. Number of tenders

No more than one tender can be submitted by a natural or legal person whatever the form of participation (as an individual legal entity or as leader or member of a consortium submitting a tender). In the event that a natural or legal person submits more than one tender, all tenders in which that person has participated will be excluded. Tenderers may not submit a tender for a variant solution in addition to their tender for the works required in the tender dossier.

11. Tender guarantee

No tender guarantee is required.

12. Performance guarantee

The successful tenderer will be asked to provide a performance guarantee of 5% of the amount of the contract at the signing of the contract. This guarantee must be provided together with the return of the countersigned contract no later than 30 days after the tenderer receives the contract signed by the Contracting Authority. If the selected tenderer fails to provide such a guarantee within this period, the contract will be void and a new contract may be drawn up and sent to the tenderer which has submitted the next cheapest compliant tender.

13. Information meeting and/or site visit

There will be no information meeting nor official site visit, because the area concerned can be

visited freely.

14. Tender validity

Tenders must remain valid for a period of 90 days after the deadline for submission of tenders. In exceptional circumstances, the Contracting Authority may, before the validity period expires, request that tenderers extend the validity of tenders for a specific period.

15. Period of implementation of tasks

The period of the implementation of the tasks is 16 months as from the date indicated in the commencement order until the date of the provisional acceptance but not later than 20.12.2019. Shorter accomplishment is possible.

SELECTION AND AWARD CRITERIA

16. Selection criteria

1. Economic and financial capacity of candidate:

- (a) the average annual turnover of the candidate in the past financially closed three years together (2014, 2015 and 2016) must exceed the amount of EUR 2.000.000;

2. Technical and professional capacity of candidate:

- a) it has at least one employee who shall act as project leader during the completion of the contract and has Msc or Bsc qualifications on the field of technical sciences, has a minimum of 24 month professional experience in the leadership of water engineering works and has the qualifications and experience required to obtain the licence marked "MV-VZ" according to the Government Decree 266/2013 (VII. 11.) or already having that (or equivalent) licence.

The completion of the contract shall only be commenced when the project leader has obtained that licence and is listed in the register of the Hungarian Chamber of Engineers as so.

- b) it has at least one employee who shall act as site manager during the completion of the contract and has Msc or Bsc qualifications on the field of technical sciences and has a minimum of 24 month professional experience in the leadership of water engineering works and has the qualifications and experience required to obtain the licence marked "MV-VZ" according to the Government Decree 266/2013 (VII. 11.) or already having that (or equivalent) licences.

The completion of the contract shall only be commenced when the person (site manager) has obtained that licence and is listed in the register of the Hungarian Chamber of Engineers with that licence.

- c) it has completed and ended - in accordance with the prescriptions of the relevant contracts - at least two contracts in the field of water engineering works including the following works:
 - dredging
 - construction of reinforced concrete culverts
 - sluice construction

- installation or reconstruction of at least one water pump station

with the budget of at least EUR 2.000.000 for one of the contracts and both within the period of eight years before the deadline for submission of tenders (03/07/2018)

This means that the taking-over certificate of the contract the tenderer refers to must have been issued within the indicated period, but it does not necessarily have to be started and completed during that period, nor implemented during the entire period.

The Contracting Authority reserves the right to ask for copies of certificates of the taking over certificate / final acceptance signed by the supervisors/contracting authority of the project concerned.

If a tender is submitted by a consortium, unless specified, the selection criteria listed above will be applied to the consortium as a whole.

17. Award criteria

The most economically advantageous tender is the technically compliant tender with the best price-quality ratio, determined by the results of the technical and financial evaluation in accordance with the weightings laid down below and in detail in the tender dossier:

Award criterion	Weighting
1. Price (net HUF)	70
2. Professional experience of the project leader (number of water engineering projects, where he/she acted as project leader – max. 5 projects)	15
3. Professional experience of the site manager (number of water engineering projects, where he/she took part – max. 5 projects)	15

The key experts presented for the above mentioned award criteria can be the same as that/those presented for the professional capacity.
