CONTRACT SPECIFICATIONS

6. Description of the contract

The planned road will be constructed directly next to the Highway 53, from the southern part of Tompa to the international border crossing point. According to the technical plans, the new bicycle route with smooth tarred surface will be 3,2 km long and 2,3 m wide in Hungary. Building permits of this cycle path is already provided (number: BK/OU/568/33/2016).

7. Number and titles of lots

One lot only

TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

8. Eligibility and rules of origin

Participation in tendering is open on equal terms to all natural and legal persons (participating either individually or in a grouping - consortium - of tenderers) which are established in one of the Member States of the European Union, or in a country or territory authorised under which the contract is financed (see also heading 23 below). Participation is also open to international organisations. All supplies and materials under this contract shall originate from one or more of those eligible countries. However, they may originate from any country when the amount value of the supplies and materials to be purchased is below 100,000 euros

9. Grounds for exclusion

Tenderers must submit a signed declaration, included in the Tender Form for a Works Contract, to the effect that they are not in any of the situations listed in point 2.3.3 of the **Practical Guide**.

10. Number of tenders

Tenderers may submit only one tender per lot. Tenders for parts of a lot will not be considered. Tenderers may not submit a tender for a variant solution in addition to their tender for the works required in the tender dossier.

11. Tender guarantee

Tenderers must provide a **tender guarantee of 1.500.000 HUF** when submitting their tender. This guarantee will be released to unsuccessful tenderers once the tender procedure has been completed and to the successful tenderer upon signature of the contract by all parties.

12. Performance guarantee

The successful tenderer will be asked to provide a performance guarantee of **5%** of the amount of the contract at the signing of the contract. This guarantee must be provided together with the return of the countersigned contract no later than 30 days after the tenderer receives the contract signed by the Contracting Authority. If the selected tenderer fails to provide such a guarantee within this period, the contract will be void and a new contract may be drawn up and sent to the tenderer which has submitted the next cheapest compliant tender.

13. Information meeting and/or site visit

No information meeting is planned.

14. Tender validity

Tenders must remain valid for a period of 90 days after the deadline for submission of tenders. In exceptional circumstances, the Contracting Authority may, before the validity period expires, request that tenderers extend the validity of tenders for a specific period.

15. Period of implementation of tasks

The implementation period of tasks from contract signature is 9 months.

SELECTION AND AWARD CRITERIA

16. Selection criteria

Economic and financial capacity of candidate:

- The **average annual turnover** of the tenderer in the **last three financial years** for which accounts have been closed must be at least **50.000.000 HUF**.

Proof documents: Statements of overall turnover for the **last three financial years**, for which accounts have been closed.

Technical and professional capacity of candidate:

- The tenderer must have completed and contractually fulfilled as a prime/main contractor or the Lead Partner of the Joint Venture / Consortium at least one **national public** road construction work contract which was at least **5000 square meter** area project during the last **five years** before the deadline for submission of tenders.

Proof documents: Declaration of the relevant road construction work must be accompanied by certificates of satisfactory execution, issued by the contacting authority or entity, who ordered or purchased the work, specifying whether they have been carried out in a professional manner and have been fully completed.

- Tenderer must employ at least one construction manager who has at least 36 months of work experience acquired as engineer on the construction of national public road as construction manager, and who has appropriate registration and licenses according to the national legislative requirements.

17. Award criteria

The most economically advantageous tender is the technically compliant tender with the lowest price.
